

Ronald Sunderland, Ed.D.

Dr. Sunderland is a minister in the Uniting Church in Australia. He is Co-founder of Interfaith CarePartners, Inc., in Houston, a congregation-based network that oversees the ministry of over 2,000 laypeople in 115 congregations serving individuals and families stricken by chronic health conditions. He was graduated in 1978 Doctor of Education from the University of Houston, and served as Adjunct Professor with Drew University School of Theology and Houston Baptist University. Dr. Sunderland was honored by the Rosalynn Carter Institute of Georgia Southwestern University as the recipient of the 1997 Rosalynn Carter Caregiving Award for his pioneering work in equipping laypeople for ministry. He is currently serving as a chaplain at The Methodist Hospital in the Medical Center.
